Stockton Unified School District offers S.T.E.P. Up to Academic Success, a 5 day a week, 3 hour after school tutoring and enrichment program at our Elementary Schools.

SUSD collaborates with community partners providing academically based, challenging enrichment activities.



**What Makes S.T.E.P. Up to Academic Success Work?**



**Staff**

Each site is staffed by SUSD and partner personnel from our many partners and may include Parks & Recreation, Boys & Girls Club, YMCA or University of Pacific students working together to provide a safe and caring environment for the students.

Training for the staff is provided by SUSD, and community providers.

**Academic Hour**

Academic tutoring with credentialed staff is provided at each site for a minimum of 3 hours a week for all grade levels. Tutoring support, based on the needs of the students, may include: reading, comprehension, writing, math, English language development and other academic areas or Homework Help.

**Enrichment Activities**

Academically based, challenging activities are offered five days a week.

Enrichment programs include health and physical fitness, homework help, self-esteem, cultural awareness, art, dance, drama, music, group and team sports and extended library hours. Adult literacy classes for parents and community activities are provided as well. Programs vary to serve the site's needs and strengths drawing on the expertise and support of community based organizations.

**S.T.E.P. Up is available at most SUSD elementary schools. Take advantage of this free after school program.**
