NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN of the intention of the Governing Board of the Stockton Unified School District (“District”) to establish criteria to determine whether school construction projects are substantially complex and subject to a retention amounts higher than five percent (5%) pursuant to the terms of Public Contract Code section 7201(b)(4).

The time and place set for the public hearing on the intention of the Governing Board of the District to establish criteria to determine whether school construction projects are substantially complex and subject to retention higher than five percent (5%) is **January 24, 2012, at 7:00 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as practicable, **at 701 N. Madison, Stockton, CA 95202**. At such time, the testimony of all interested persons for or against the proposed finding will be heard.

Any protest pertaining to the regularity or sufficiency of the proceedings shall be in writing and shall clearly set forth the irregularities and defects on the basis of which the objection is made. Any written protest shall be filed with the Clerk of the District on or before the time set for the hearing. The District may waive any irregularities in the form or content of any written notice and at the hearing may correct minor defects in the proceedings.
